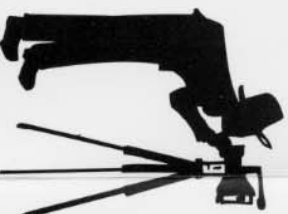
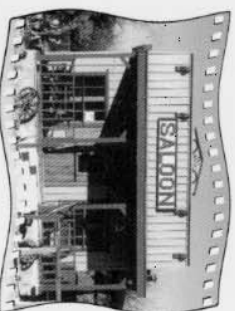
Upon arrival you will be greeted by our friendly Saloon keeper.
